Now he's ready to cast his line. His fifth fish weighs in at 7 lbs and is a largemouth. He did it! He caught his limit. His total weight is 23 ½ lbs.

Taking the lead today is Kevin Vandam with a total weight of 23 ½ lbs. Kevin will receive \$500,000 in cash and a big trophy to take home. Second place is Aaron Martins. His final weight was 19 lbs.
